The journal aims to provide an opportunity for the publication of outputs by, and for, veterinary nurses, veterinary technicians, and allied veterinary professionals.

Co-edited by Unitec's Laura Harvey and Otago Polytechnic's Kristina Naden, the journal will primarily publish research papers, short reports of up to 2,000 words, literature reviews, and high-quality case studies. All manuscripts will be subject to anonymous double-blind peer review, prior to acceptance and publication. Papers will be published online as soon as they are accepted, with the first issue being a collation of papers. The inaugural issue will be published in September 2022, and we are accepting manuscript submissions now.
