

2019 Pacific Masters Scholarships Terms and Conditions

Successful applicants who are awarded scholarships are expected to:

- Abide by all Unitec regulations and all programme regulations relevant to their ٠ course of study.
- Maintain satisfactory progress toward degree (a minimum of a B- average in all coursework, with no failing grades).
- Maintain continuous enrolment, at part-time (30 credits per semester) or full-time (60 credits per semester) levels each semester, as per degree regulations, unless otherwise authorised by the Programme Committee and approved by the Postgraduate Research and Scholarships Committee.
- Complete a research thesis of at least 90 credits.
- Complete programme of study within the prescribed timeframe.
- Commence study in 2019.

Important:

- The scholarship may be concurrently held with other awards or grants as long as • the Director of Pacific Success is advised and approves, and the terms of those awards or grants permit.
- The scholarship must be taken in 2019, it cannot be deferred. In the event that the student decides to start their studies beyond 2019, they will have to forfeit this scholarship and they will be eligible to reapply for the scholarship again, but must complete a fresh application and re-supply all of the requested supporting documentation.
