<u>Admission Requirements Policy</u>

To be eligible for admission, you must meet two admission requirements:

- Requirements for general admission
- English language requirements

Most domestic (NZ) students enter through general admission. If you do not meet the requirements for general admission, special admission, or discretionary admission may be available.

General Admission

To apply for this programme, candidates are required to meet all of the below entry requirements.

All applicants should normally have completed Year 13 in a New Zealand secondary school or its equivalent and:

- gained a minimum of 14 Level 3 NCEA credits in at least one approved subject
- gained a minimum of 10 credits at Level 3 (or higher) in two other approved subjects
- achieved at least 10 credits in Mathematics at NCEA Level 1 or higher
- achieved at least 4 credits in reading and 4 credits in writing at Level 2 or higher in English or Te Reo Maori on the National Qualifications Framework. These literacy credits must be from a schedule of approved achievement and unit standards.

Or, have passed the Unitec Certificate in Foundation Studies (Level 3): Whitinga with a grade average of B- (65%) or above.

English Language Requirements

International students are required to have English language proficiency of IELTS 6.0 overall with a minimum of 5.0 in each band, or a 'B' average in the DEEP Academic English qualification.
