- New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- a member of the New Zealand Institute of Quantity Surveyors (NZIQS)
- enrolled in one of the following degree programmes, majoring in quantity surveying/construction economics:
 - Bachelor of Construction (Quantity Surveying) Massey University
 - Bachelor of Construction (Construction Economics) UNITEC
 - Bachelor of Construction (Quantity Surveying) Future Skills Academy
 - Bachelor of Construction (Quantity Surveying) Ara Institute of Canterbury
 - Bachelor of Construction (Quantity Surveying) Otago Polytechnic
 - Bachelor of Construction (Quantity Surveying) Southern Institute of Technology
- commencing their second year of degree study in 2022.

- Academic achievement as demonstrated in course results to date
- Motivation to achieve in their study and in the industry
- Openness and willingness to learn
