### Step 4

Once you open your study plan, you can select the courses you are planning to take. There are some important tips to read before you select your courses.

1. Read the Programme Specific Requirements to make sure you take all the required credits. e.g. Bachelor of Construction/Construction Economics (BCONS/QUANSURV)

#### Programme Specific Requirements

Required Credits to Graduate = 360 credits in total:

Level 5 = 90 Credits (90 Compulsory)

Level 6 = 120 Credits (120 Compulsory)

Level 7 = 75 Credits (60 Compulsory + 15 Elective)

Plus 60 Credits from any BCONS or approved Unitec Programme Elective courses at Level 5,6 or 7.

You must successfully pass all compulsory courses. The remainder of your credits will be made up of self selected elective choices.

2. Check Requisites Key

#### Requisites Key

Pre-req/s: Prerequisites must be taken prior to the course

Co-req/s: Corequisites must be taken at the same time or prior to taking the course

Restriction/s: If you have successfully passed restricted courses you cannot take the course
