
## Accessing Echo360

## Getting started

1. You will have a link in your Moodle course that says Access Echo360 here:



2. When you click on this link it will take you into your course/section that looks a bit like this:



- 3. The class list is like a homepage. From here you can click on a class to enter the classroom and view a video or a presentation.
- 4. Each class has its' own Q&A or discussions feature where you can ask questions or respond to questions posted by your class mates. You can also take notes that sit alongside the presentation or video.



The icons are in order: notes, discussion, ask a question, bookmark, flag confusion and return to class list.

Finally as a Student, you have access to the Echo360 app that you can use to view your class media, ask questions, and take notes on the go. While using the App is fairly straightforward, there are a few things you need to know about using it.

**NOTE:** it is best if you can access Echo360 through Moodle first before using the app.

In order to use the app, you need to create an Echo360 password. Students who enter Echo360 through Moodle are simply passed into Echo360. We have your email address but you don't have a password. The Mobile App requires you to log in, and that means having an Echo360 password. It can be the same as or different than your Moodle password, as long as it meets the complexity requirements (it needs to be quite long, have a capital and a number).

While in Echo360, click the Settings icon and select Account Settings. There you should find a great big CREATE button. Use this to create your Echo360 password.

## Livestream instructions

If your class is being livestreamed you can access from the class from remote. Just log into Moodle, click on the Echo access link and you will see the live stream class clearly labelled.

Click on that class and as soon as the scheduled class starts, you will see the livestream.
